Guests of Wroclaw remember the city as an enterprising culture centre first of all. Five theatres, opera, musical theatre, philharmonic, numerous clubs, museums and galleries ensure the continuous stream of artistic events. Musical festivals of an international significance have become a signature of the city. The most important of them is the International Festival "Wratistavia Cantans" – Music and Fine Arts. Wroclaw is fourth largest city in Poland, with around 650 thousands inhabitants. It is one of the largest academic centres in the country.

Intellectual life is concentrated around 13 academies, primed by with the University and the University of Technology.

It is a very important communication node; 3 international routes, 2 large railroad depots, 2 inland waterway ports and an international airport are located in the city, which allows for the connection with the entire world.

The most important role in the region's economy have the industries of transport means, machines, electrical engineering, metal constructions and food.

Wroclaw is an astonishing city with a rich history and a unique beauty. Its values are appreciated both by its citizens and visitors
